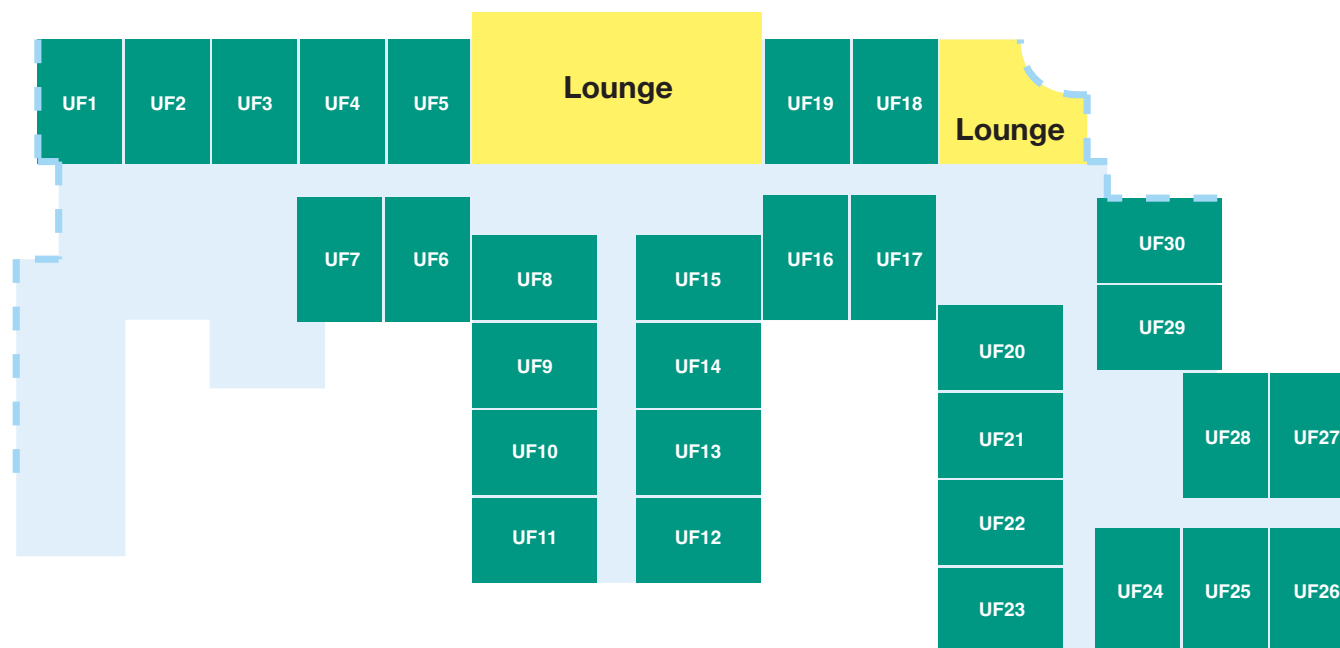

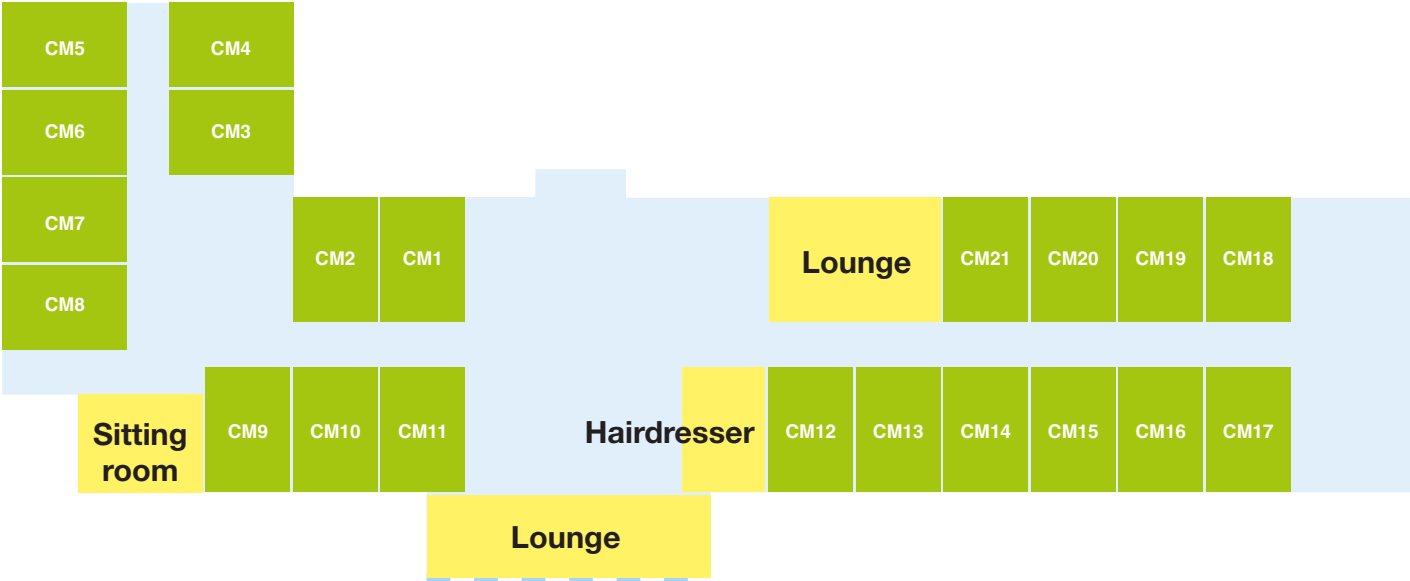

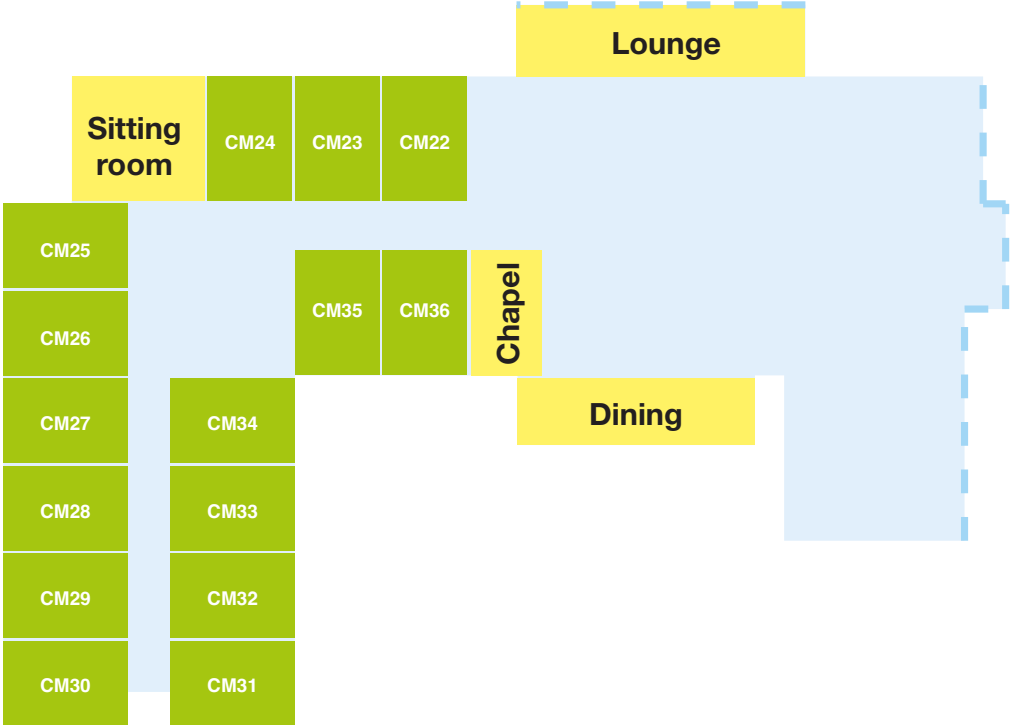
DELUXE

Mercy Place Shepparton (South) – Catherine McAuley South Wing

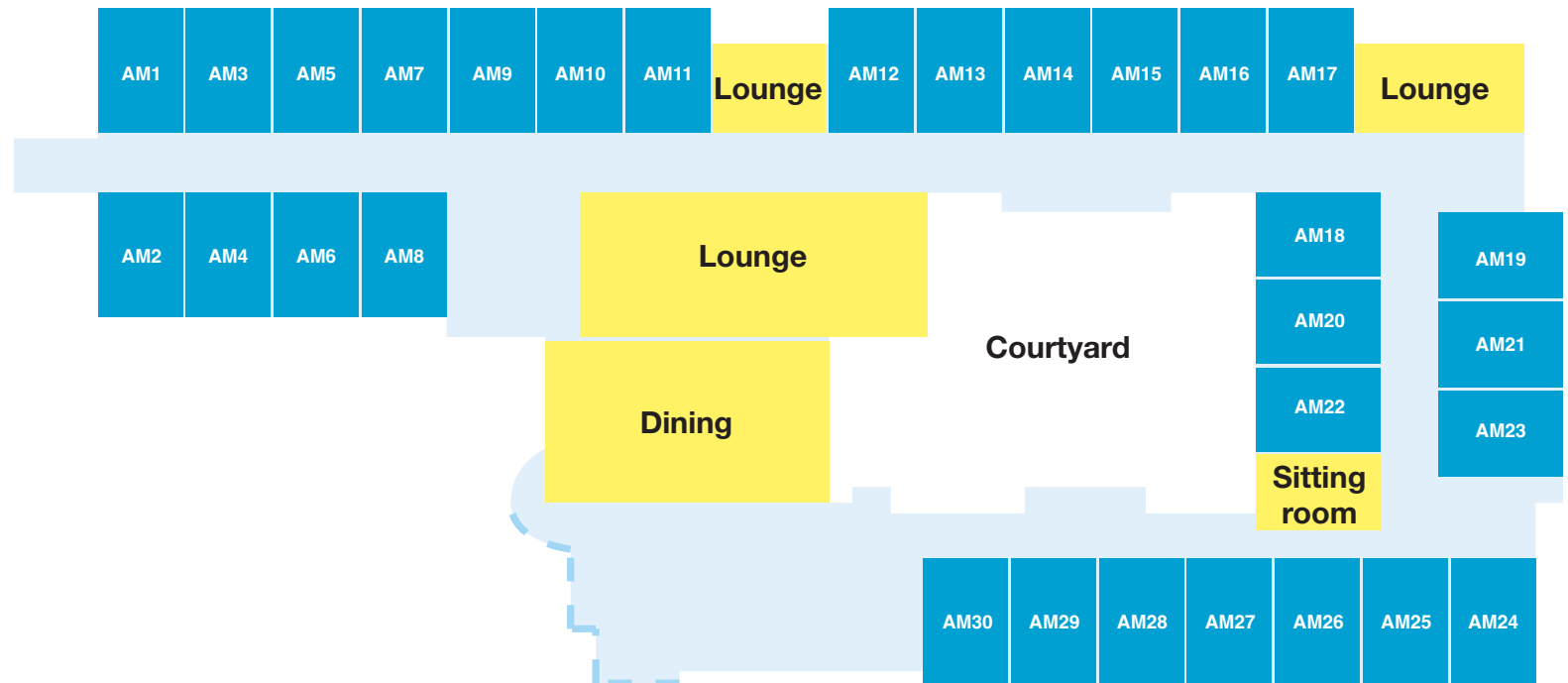

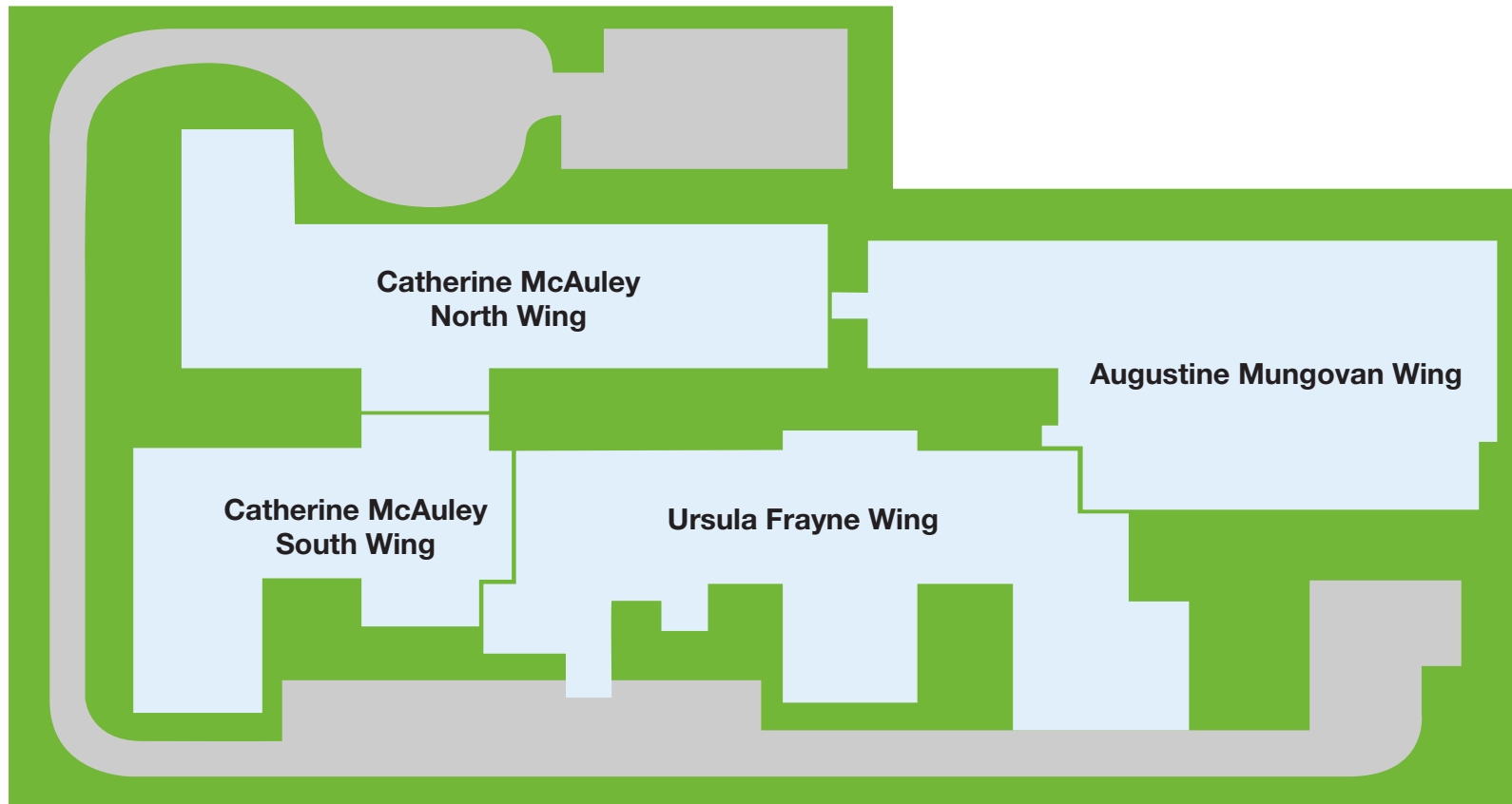
Mercy Place Shepparton (South) – Augustine Mungovan Wing
