

## Your care team


Each household is supported by dedicated care staff who will get to know you and how you like to spend your day. They will help you and your fellow residents plan the weekly menu and organise social activities and outings.

### Our rooms

You can choose to pay for your room by a **Refundable Accommodation Deposit (RAD)**, a **Daily Accommodation Payment (DAP)** or any combination you choose. A RAD is paid as a lump sum. A DAP accrues daily and is paid periodically, for example monthly. A combination payment includes a partial lump sum and daily payments. We also offer a drawdown option.

#### DELUXE+




#### **SUPERIOR**


#### SUPERIOR+



#### DELUXE+



#### **PREMIER+**


