Choosing a room

Additional features include heating, air conditioning and wallmounted TVs. A 24/7 nurse call system is available in all rooms, giving you and your loved ones peace of mind.

Our rooms

You can choose to pay for your room by a **Refundable Accommodation Deposit (RAD)**, a **Daily Accommodation Payment (DAP)** or any combination you choose. A RAD is paid as a lump sum. A DAP accrues daily and is paid periodically, for example monthly. A combination payment includes a partial lump sum and daily payments. We also offer a drawdown option.




DELUXE
