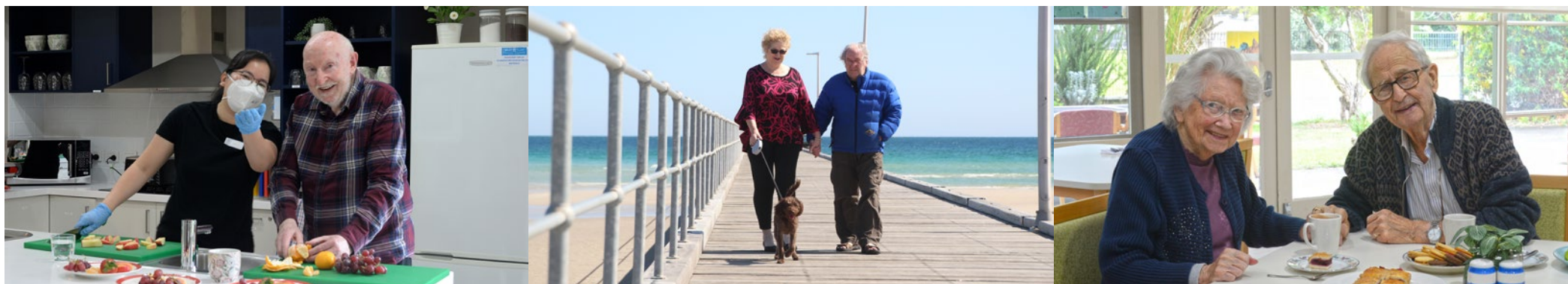

# Our rooms

You can choose to pay for your room by a **Refundable Accommodation Deposit (RAD)**, a **Daily Accommodation Payment (DAP)** or any combination you choose. A RAD is paid as a lump sum. A DAP accrues daily and is paid periodically, for example monthly. A combination payment includes a partial lump sum and daily payments. We also offer a drawdown option.

Located in the Hakea and Banksia houses, these south or east-facing Grande rooms feature private ensuites and heating to keep you cosy in the colder winter months.

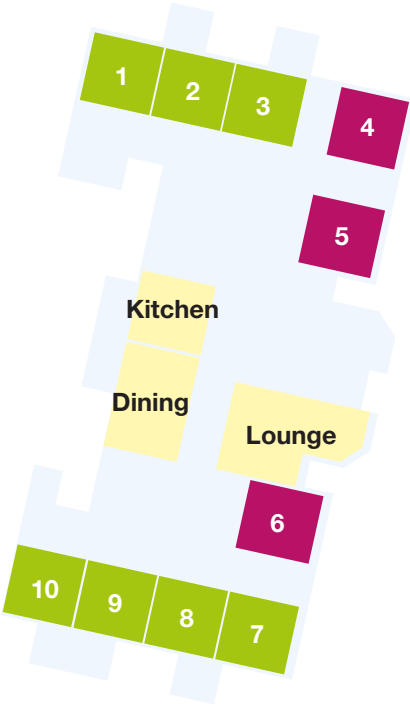
## GRANDE+

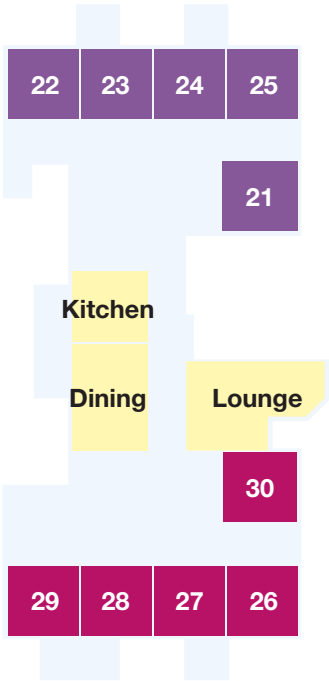
## DELUXE

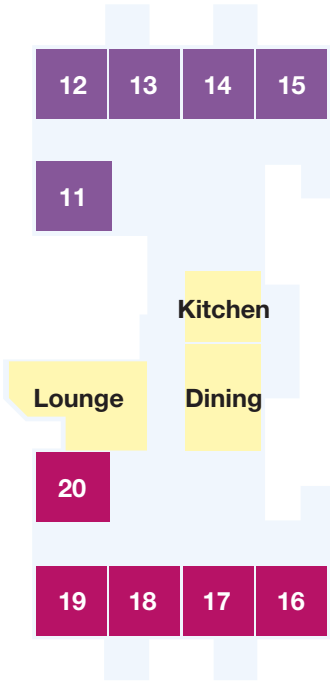
