Choosing a room

Our lovely rooms in St Joseph's House and Catherine McAuley House are all beautifully designed with private ensuites and easy access to common areas. Enjoy the spacious rooms appointed with high-quality fittings, including individually controlled hydronic heating, built-in wardrobes and ample storage for your personal treasures. Most of the rooms also have full-length windows with sliding doors to gardens or courtyards.

For those living with dementia or memory loss, we have a dedicated Memory Support Unit located in St Joseph's House.



Our rooms

You can choose to pay for your room by a **Refundable Accommodation Deposit (RAD)**, a **Daily Accommodation Payment (DAP)** or any combination you choose. A RAD is paid as a lump sum. A DAP accrues daily and is paid periodically, for example monthly. A combination payment includes a partial lump sum and daily payments. We also offer a drawdown option.

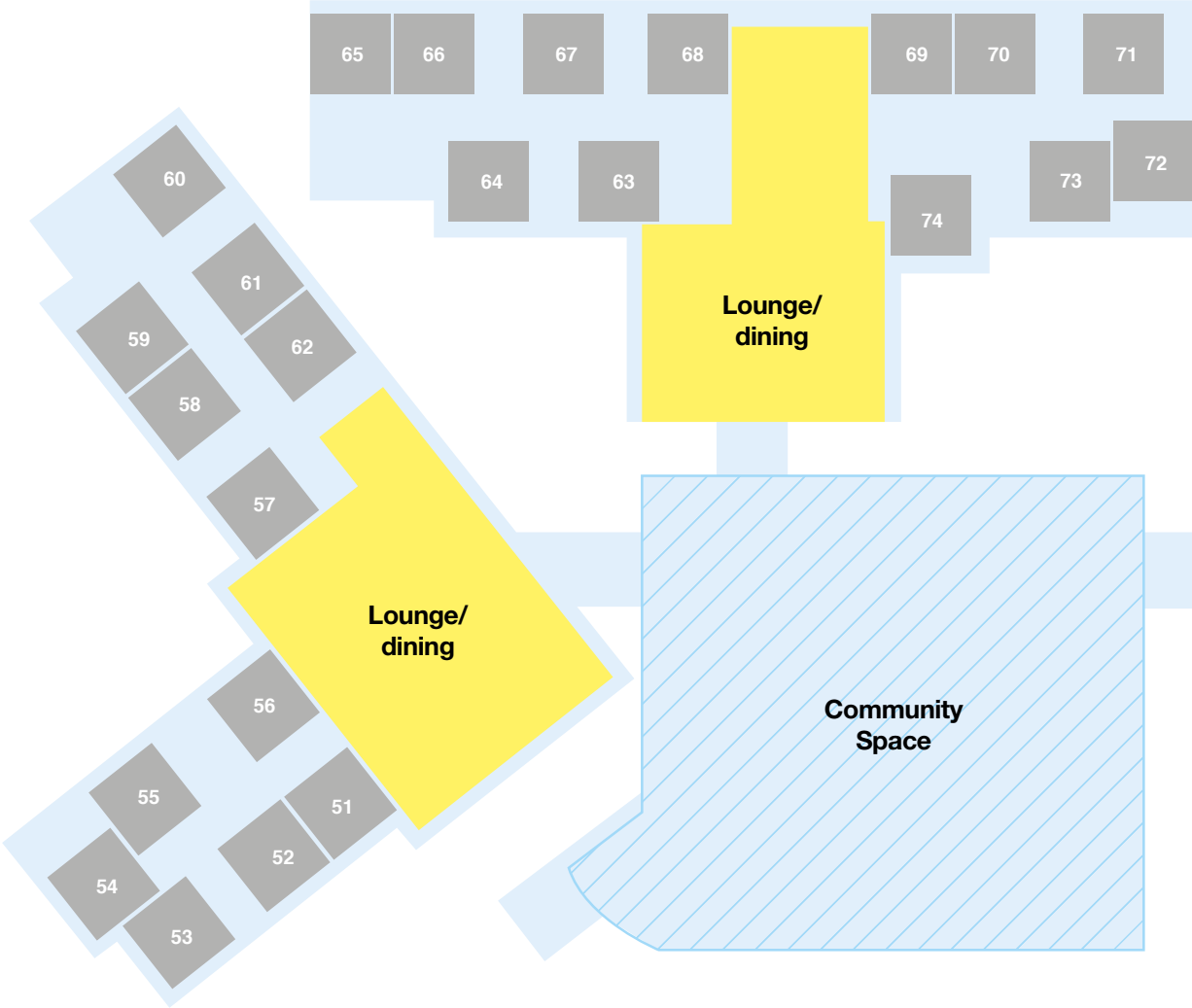
CLASSIC

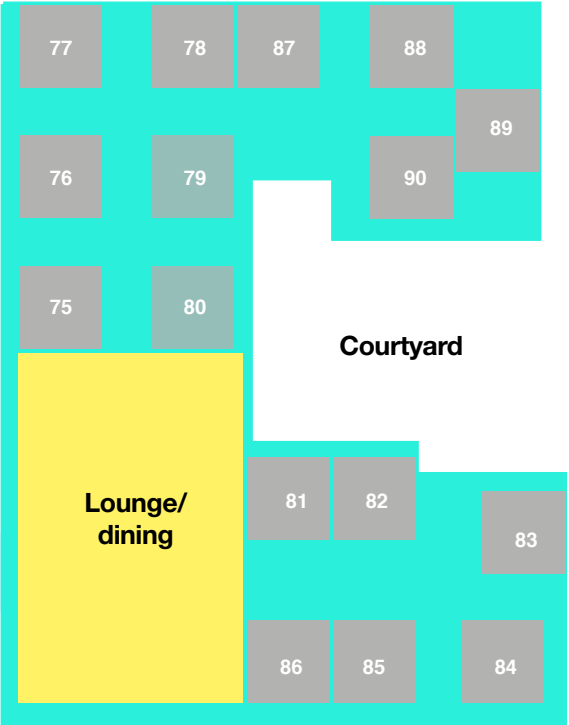
