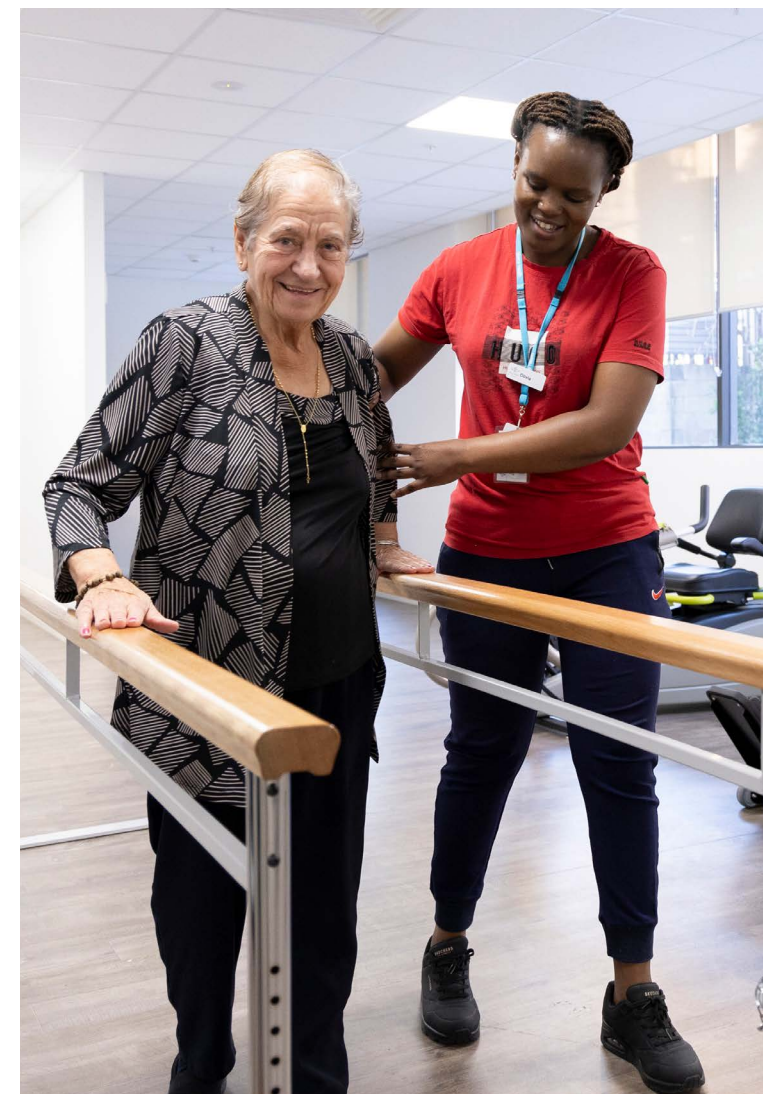
The ground floor features a wellness centre that includes an activities room, gym, hairdressing salon, cafe and a chapel, designed to keep residents, families and the broader community connected.

Choosing a room

Consider the room's location and its proximity to the services and amenities that matter most to you, such as communal spaces, a hairdressing salon, or a wellness centre. More than just a place to stay, your room should be a space where you feel relaxed, secure, and truly at home.

All rooms at Our Lady Mercy Place Harris Park are decorated with comfort and style in mind. Each room features a private ensuite fitted with safety handrails and anti-slip flooring; a bedside table with an overhead reading lamp and a modern study desk with chair. An individually controlled split system air conditioner, quality blinds, light fittings and furniture are all included to make your room your special space.

A 24/7 nurse call system is available in all rooms, giving you and your loved ones peace of mind.



Room categories

Our team is here to help guide you through the various options, ensuring you fully understand the costs associated with each type of room.

CLASSIC

All Classic rooms are on the first floor where you will enjoy easy access to communal areas as well as the internal courtyard.

DELUXE

Choose one of our Deluxe rooms on either the first or second floors. First floor rooms can be north-facing with a view of the local neighbourhood while others look out onto the internal courtyard. Second floor Deluxe rooms have a view to the Our Lady of Lebanon Co-cathedral.

DELUXE+

Deluxe+ rooms are available on the first and second floors. Select a first floor room with natural light that looks out onto Elizabeth Farm or choose one of two rooms that have their own balcony facing the Co-cathedral. Second floor Deluxe+ rooms will either look out onto the internal courtyard or have a north-facing view.

PREMIER

Premier rooms are available on the first, second and third floors. Two of the larger rooms on the first floor are north-facing while others have direct access to the courtyard. We have five Premier rooms on the second floor facing Elizabeth Farm, while the other three rooms face north towards the local neighbourhood.

The only Premier room on the third floor is close to the lounge and dining rooms with easy access to a balcony overlooking the internal courtyard.

PREMIER +

Premier+ rooms have a variety of views on offer depending on the floor you choose. From Elizabeth Farm to the Co-cathedral to a view of the internal courtyard, welcome the natural light and have your preference of a private balcony or access to a shared terrace.

SUPERIOR

Our Superior rooms on the third floor all have balcony access, either north-facing or overlooking the first floor courtyard. Choose a fourth floor Superior room where you will have the best view of the neighbouring Co-cathedral and rooftop terrace access.

SUPERIOR+

Secure one of the larger Superior+ rooms available on the second, third and fourth floors. All of these rooms either have their own balcony or direct access to one. The St Charbel Superior room is one of the largest rooms on the second floor while all the St Mary MacKillop rooms on the third floor look straight onto the Co-cathedral. The Superior+ rooms on the top floor have easy access to the rooftop terrace and the splendid views of Harris Park's surrounds.

EXECUTIVE

Our best and largest rooms are ready for your indulgence. Select one of three stunning Executive rooms on the third floor with direct access to your own and surrounding balconies. With extra space for your own additional furniture, your room will be the envy of many.
