Bringing its healthy ageing approach to Harris Park, Mercy Health is committed to caring for the whole person — body, mind and soul, in a home where residents can feel safe, comfortable and valued.

With 86 rooms spread over four floors, balconies and outdoor terraces are prominent on the upper floors to give residents beautiful views of surrounding parkland, the city skyline and

neighbouring Our Lady of Lebanon Co-cathedral.

The ground floor features a wellness centre that includes an activities room, gym, hairdressing salon, cafe and a chapel, designed to keep residents, families and the broader community connected.

Our Lady Mercy Place Harris Park is ideally situated just metres from Elizabeth Farm and in close proximity to a range of amenities and public transport.

Choosing a room

All rooms at Our Lady Mercy Place Harris Park are decorated with comfort and style in mind. Each room features a private ensuite fitted with safety handrails and anti-slip flooring; a bedside table with an overhead reading lamp and a modern study desk with chair. An individually controlled split system air conditioner, quality blinds, light fittings and furniture are all included to make your room your special space.

A 24/7 nurse call system is available in all rooms, giving you and your loved ones peace of mind.

Our rooms

You can choose to pay for your room by a **Refundable Accommodation Deposit (RAD)**, a **Daily Accommodation Payment (DAP)** or any combination you choose. A RAD is paid as a lump sum. A DAP accrues daily and is paid periodically, for example monthly. A combination payment includes a partial lump sum and daily payments. We also offer a drawdown option.

Premier rooms are available on the first, second and third floors. Two of the larger rooms on the first floor are north-facing while others have direct access to the courtyard. We have five Premier rooms on the second floor facing Elizabeth Farm, while the other three rooms face north towards the local neighbourhood. The only Premier room on the third floor is close to the lounge and dining rooms with easy access to a balcony overlooking the internal courtyard.

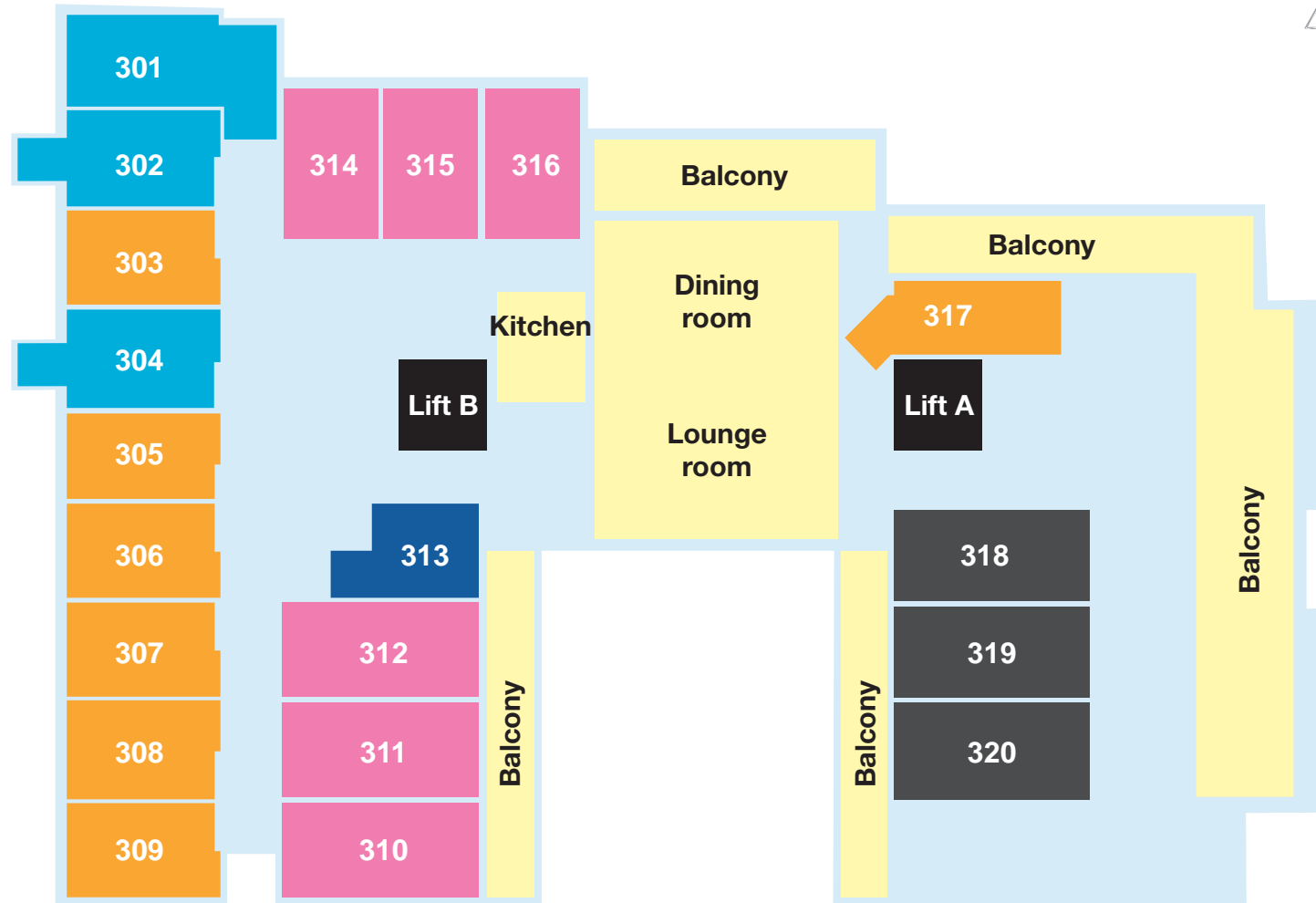
SUPERIOR+

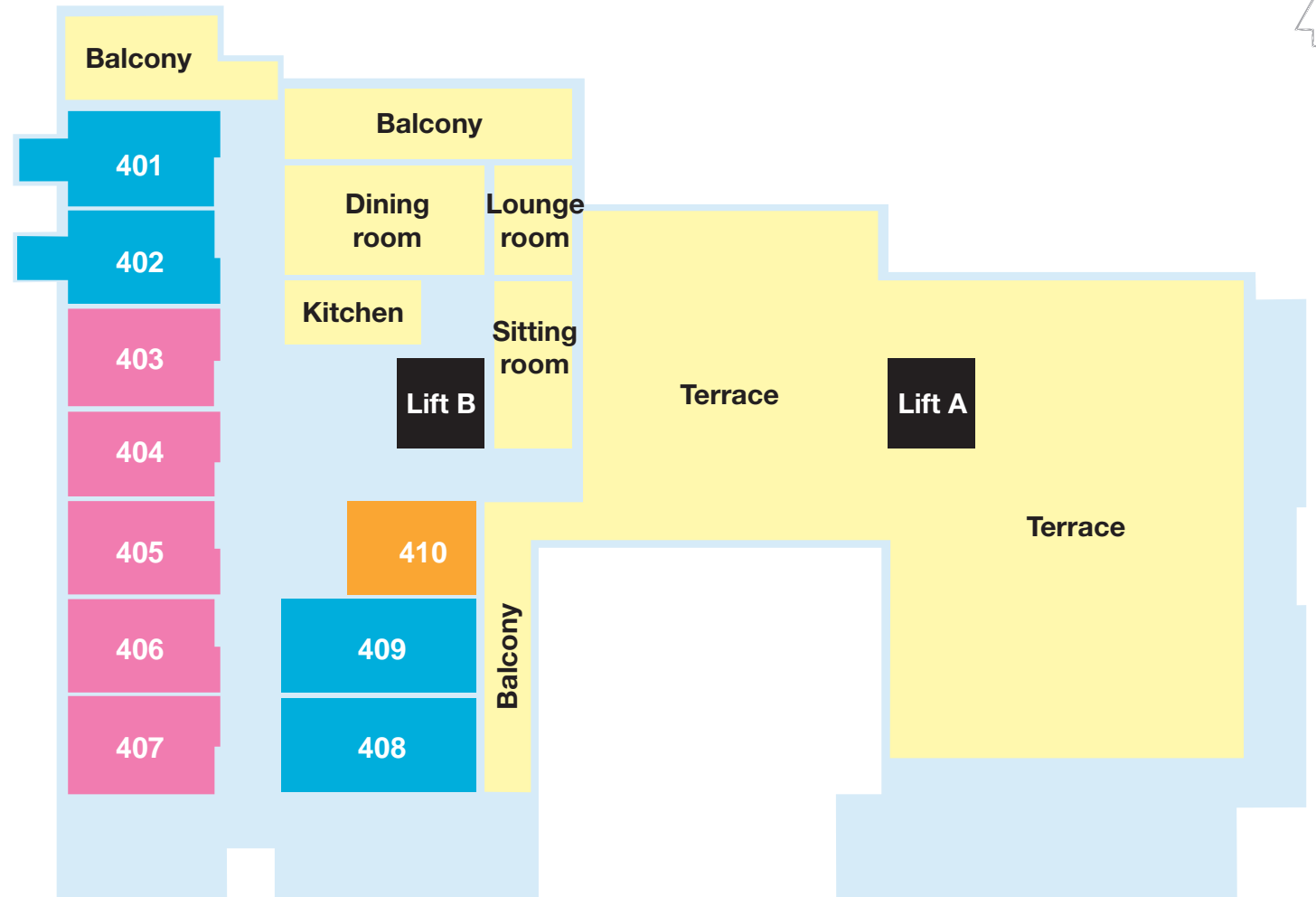
