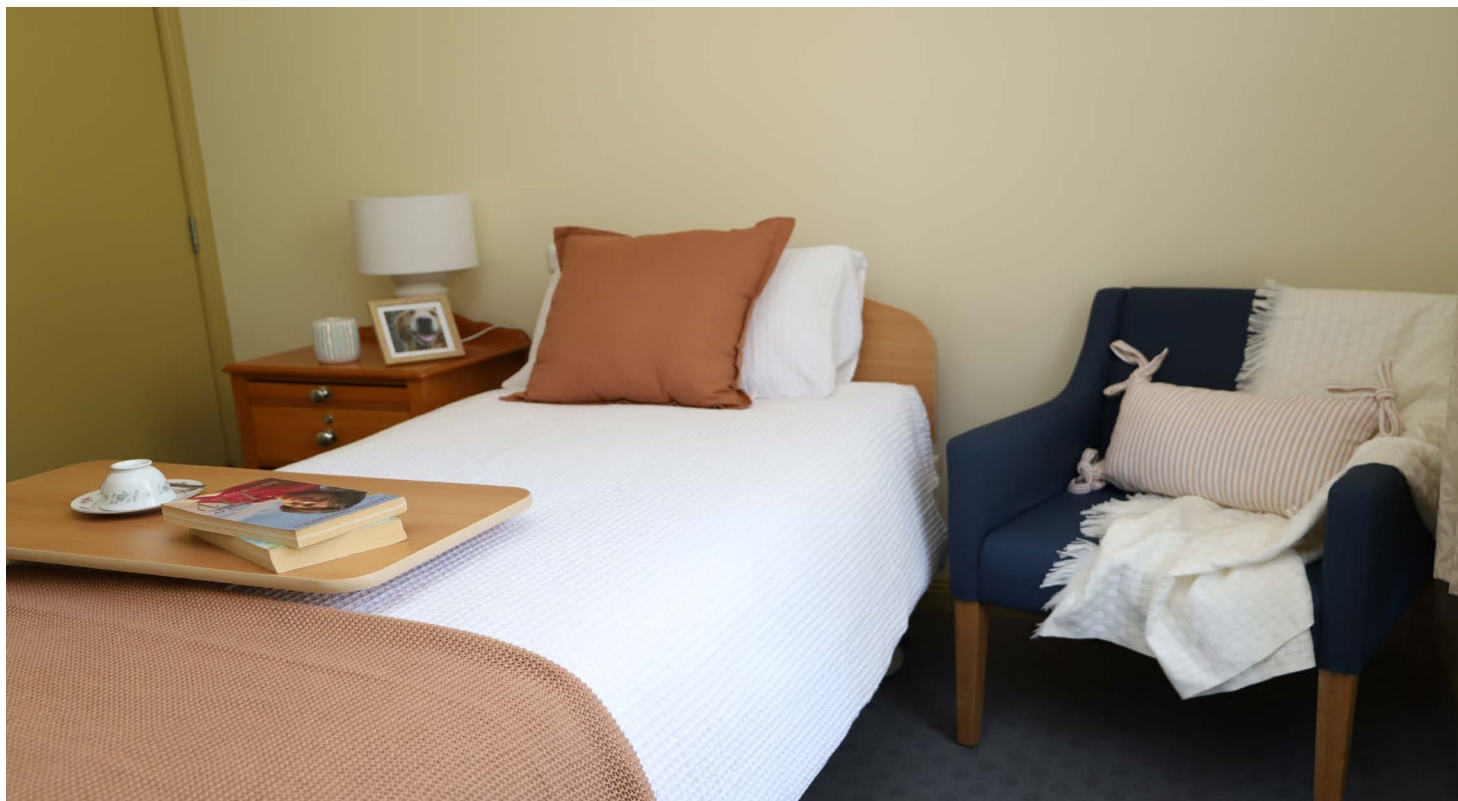


Choosing a room
